John A. Pérez is the executive director of the United Food and Commercial Workers Union (UFCW) Region 8 States Council, representing California, Arizona, Nevada and Hawaii. The UFCW represents more than 200,000 workers in the retail grocery, meat, drug and related industries in California and 1.4 million workers nationwide.
